Waste Management is required by Michigan state law, to notify their customers of materials prohibited from landfill disposal.

Waste Management reminds us not to put any of the following in the dumpsters:

- a) Medical waste
- b) Beverage containers (that require a 10 cent deposit)
- c) Whole motor vehicle tires
- d) Yard Clippings (Leaves, grass clippings,

garden debris, and shrubbery, brush and tree trimmings less than 4 feet in length and 2 inches in diameter, unless they are diseased or infested.

- e) Used oil
- f) Lead acid batteries
- g) Low-level radioactive waste
- h) Regulated hazardous waste
- i) Liquid waste
- j) Sewage
- k) PCBs
- l) Asbestos waste
- m) Empty drums
